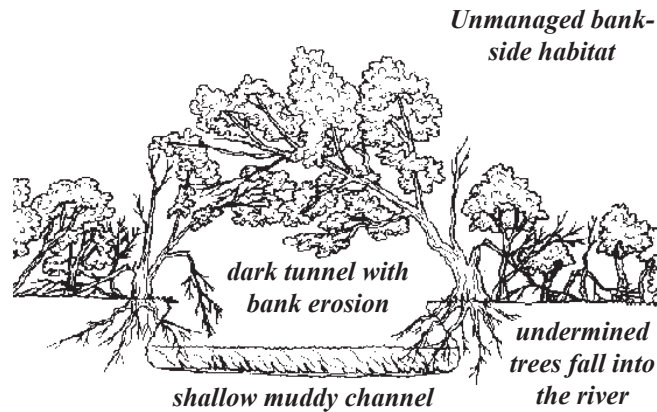


River Bank Management

Coppicing



Traditionally bankside trees were cut every few years (coppiced) for firewood, fencing and roofing materials.

Habitat for fish and wildlife can be improved by reinstating coppicing of bankside trees.

As a rule of thumb; leave shade on the pools and let sunlight shine on the “riffles” by coppicing.

If trees are cut close to the ground every few years
