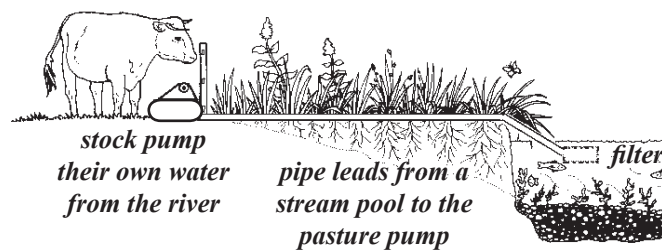


Stock Drinking

Pasture Pump

If farm animals are being excluded from a water-course a pasture pump is one of a number of ways of allowing them to drink river water.



The pump is fixed firmly to the ground on a large piece of wood or fencing post.

A pipe feeds water from a nearby pool via a filter into the pump.

Animals pump their drinking water from the river to a bowl by pushing a ram with their noses.
