

Water Treatment Area

Inflow pipe brings oily rain water from the car park and farm yard

Wetland is planted with a range of native species including marsh marigold, canary grass and phragmites

Since oil is lighter than water it remains on the surface and is broken down by bacteria in the wetland

Clean water sinks below the oil and enters the outflow pipe

Gravel prevents silt from blocking the outflow pipe

Clean water flows from the out flow pipe to fill the ponds
